We will begin our City Tour with a journey through colonial and contemporary Lima, enjoying a beautiful view of the Pacific Ocean.

We will then head to the Pueblo Libre district to visit the Larco Museum. This museum houses the world's finest and most complete collection of pre-Columbian gold and silver. OPTION 5: PALOMINO ISLANDS

Discover the Palomino Islands on a boat tour departing from Lima. Encounter sea lions, swim with them, and enjoy panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean. Expert guides will share insights about the islands' rich wildlife. You will be picked up and taken to the province of Callao, located 17 km from the Miraflores district.

The tour begins at 10:30 AM at Plaza Grau Pier in Callao. After check-in, we will sail towards Camotal or Callao Hundido, a historic site and part of the Callao archipelago. We will then navigate around San Lorenzo Island, the largest island in the country, and El Frontón Island, often referred to as the Peruvian Alcatraz.

Thirty minutes later, we will arrive at the Palomino Islands, a natural reserve home to over 5,000 sea lions. We will stay at the Palomino Islands for approximately 30 to 35 minutes. Here, you will have the unforgettable opportunity to swim and play with the friendly sea lions.

On our way back to Callao Port, enjoy stunning ocean views and observe various bird species native to the area, including the Humboldt penguin. After the boat trip, you will be returned to your hotel.

OPTION 6: LIMA AT NIGHT WITH MAGIC WATER CIRCUIT

Discover Lima at night with the Magic Water Circuit. Enjoy a tour of the city lights, mesmerizing, illuminated fountains, and a tasting of traditional Peruvian treats such as "anticuchos," "picarones," or "mazamorra morada with arroz con leche," paired with a glass of "chicha morada."

In the evening, visit the Magic Water Circuit Park, recognized by the Guinness World Records as the largest fountain complex in a public park. This magnificent park features thirteen ornamental fountains with stunning displays of laser lights, music, and images that synchronize perfectly with the movement of the water.

After this enchanting show, we'll head to Alameda Chabuca Granda to experience local nightlife. You'll have the opportunity to try popular foods, drinks, and desserts like the famous anticuchos, picarones, and chicha morada.

The experience continues with a tour of the Historic Center of the capital.

OPTION 7: PACHACAMAC WITH LUNCH AND PERUVIAN PASO HORSE EXHIBITION

Explore the ancient Ichma and Inca structures at Pachacamac, followed by a delightful lunch and a fascinating Peruvian Paso Horse show for a truly memorable day.

Visit the Pachacamac Citadel, often referred to as the "Rome of the Andes," with its temples, streets, pyramids, and cemeteries. This site was home to the most famous oracle of the Andean world at the time, where people from all corners of the Tahuantinsuyo Empire would journey to seek guidance about their destiny and that of their communities. Here, they could learn about the outcomes of significant battles, potential droughts, and cataclysms.

We will then head to the themed restaurant Dpaso Mamacona, where you'll learn about the history of the Peruvian Paso Horse. You can participate in a Pisco Sour demonstration and tasting, followed by a Creole buffet accompanied by traditional dances from Peru's coast, highlands, and jungle regions.

Next, enjoy the Peruvian Paso Horse Show presented by the Navarro Falcón family, National Champions and Peru Brand Ambassadors. This performance, recognized by the Ministry of Culture as a cultural event of interest, is an unforgettable experience. After the show, you'll have the opportunity to take photos with the performers and, optionally, ride a horse in the local arena.

At the end of the experience, we will transfer you back to your hotel.

DAY 1 | EXPLORING ICA - HISTORY, WINE AND ADVENTURE

The adventure begins early in the morning at your hotel in Lima, where our driver will pick you up and take you to the Cruz del Sur terminal. From there, you'll board a comfortable bus to Paracas, a journey of approximately 3.5 hours. Along the way, enjoy the stunning Peruvian coastal scenery, with its vast sand dunes and the deep blue Pacific Ocean stretching to the horizon.

Upon arrival in Paracas, you'll be greeted by our local team and transferred to your hotel to drop off your luggage. But there's no time to lose—the next stop is Ica, famous for its wineries and rich cultural heritage.

Our lunch destination is the historic Hacienda Tacama, the oldest winery in the Americas. Here, you'll enjoy a traditional Peruvian lunch in a picturesque setting surrounded by vineyards. Tacama is renowned not only for its wine but also for producing pisco, Peru's iconic spirit.

After lunch, you'll join the Grand Tasting Tour at Tambo de Tacama. A knowledgeable guide will walk you through the winery's history, production processes, and, of course, guide you through a tasting of its finest wines and piscos. You'll learn to distinguish the unique subtleties of each variety.

In the afternoon, we'll head to the Ica City Tour, which includes a visit to the Regional Museum. Here, you'll uncover the pre-Columbian history of the region with an impressive collection of mummies, ceramics, and artifacts from ancient cultures such as the Paracas and Nazca.

The day's adrenaline rush comes with an exciting sandboarding and dune buggy adventure on the breathtaking dunes of Huacachina. The day ends with an unforgettable sunset over the dunes, as the golden and orange hues paint the desert landscape.

After this action-packed day, you'll return to Paracas to relax at the selected hotel. The first day concludes with a well-deserved rest after exploring the best of Ica's culture, wine, and adventure.

DAY 2 | NATURE AND RELAXATION IN PARACAS

The second day begins with an impressive natural spectacle: the Ballestas Islands. After an early breakfast, you'll head to the port to embark on an excursion to these vibrant islands. Onboard, you'll explore rocky formations inhabited by Humboldt penguins, sea lions, and a wide variety of seabirds.

As the boat sails, you'll also have the chance to admire the mysterious Candelabra, an enigmatic figure etched into the coastal desert hills.

After the excursion, you'll return to the hotel to relax before heading out for lunch at the Reserva Paracas Restaurant, where you'll enjoy a delicious regional menu paired with spectacular views of Paracas Bay.

TRUJILLO IS MARINERA + PERUVIAN PASO HORSE SHOW

This package is designed for you. Enjoy the top-tier archaeological sites in Trujillo. Local cuisine, paired with our savory seafood, are two more reasons, more than enough to justify the trip.

DAY 1 | CITY TOUR TRUJILLO

Reception at the Bus Station or Airport. Accommodation at hotels. Free morning. At the scheduled time, we will pick you up from your accommodation to head to the Plaza de Armas, the starting point of this fascinating tour where we will learn about its history; the foundation of Trujillo, which according to some specialists was in November 1534 by the conqueror Diego de Almagro, naming it Trujillo de Nueva Castilla in reference to the birthplace of Francisco Pizarro (Trujillo de Extremadura - Spain). We will visit the Cathedral, a typical religious building constructed by the Spaniards; the Monument to Liberty, designed and built by the German sculptor Edmund Müller in 1921, who won the contest to create an allegory to the Spanish liberation process; We will visit the Casa Calonge Urquiaga, headquarters of the BCR and home of the Liberator Simón Bolívar during his emancipation campaign; we will stroll along Pizarro pedestrian promenade, where you will find the La Merced Church, the Casa de La Emancipación - BBVA, also known as the mansion with large windows and where the original document confirming the use of the city's coat of arms is held, Palacio Iturregui: currently the headquarters of the Central Club, one of the most beautiful colonial-republican mansions in Trujillo that maintains its original architecture. Next, we will visit the museum of archaeology, anthropology, and history of U.N.T. which will give us a general understanding of the development of the pre-Columbian cultures in Trujillo, such as the Moche or Mochica Culture and the Chimú Culture. Finally, we will arrive at a beautiful and historic place called Plazuela el Recreo, where the water reservoir of Trujillo's historic center is located, which was used during the colonial era; return to your accommodation.

DAY 2 | SUN AND MOON PYRAMIDS + CHAN CHAN

We will also visit the Sun and Moon Temples, showcasing original friezes and murals. We will head about 9 kilometers south of Trujillo and cross the Moche River bridge. Our first stop will be at the outskirts of the Huaca del Sol, known to have been part of the administrative area of the Moche urban center; Our next stop will be at the Las Huacas de Moche Site Museum, inaugurated on June 24, 2010, where pieces found throughout the archaeological zone are displayed. The Moche Culture developed between 100 – 700 AD. Continuing with our program, we will visit the archaeological site of the Huaca de La Luna, where we will explore its various areas, highlighting the polychrome murals in high relief, a fine artistic expression of the Moche worldview, with the figure of AI APAEC standing out.

After the visit, we will head to the Chan Chan Site Museum, which belongs to the Chimú Culture that developed between 800 – 1400 AD. We will then continue our tour to the Nikan Palace, the last building constructed by the Chimú, and the smallest of all the 10 palaces; the Chimú people excelled in the construction of monumental buildings, as evidenced by their large courtyards and terraces. The Chan Chan citadel was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1986 and is considered the largest adobe city in the world.

Finally, we will head to the Huanchaco beach resort, traditionally known for artisanal fishing using the totora reed boat, where we will have time to enjoy lunch with a sea view.

Return to your accommodation.

DAY 3 | EXHIBITION OF MARINERA HORSES AND PERUVIAN PASO HORSES

Peruvian Paso Horse Show, Marinera Dance, Choreography, and other typical dances.

At the scheduled time, we will pick you up from your accommodation to head west of Trujillo to the Buenos Aires district, where ALCORP is located, a place where the Peruvian Paso horse is bred. It is known for its elegance and smooth gait. It is ridden by a "Chalán," who wears a linen poncho and a wide-brimmed hat. We will enjoy an artistic show that begins with an explanation about this breed, the role they played during the hacienda era, the traditional attire, and then there will be an exhibition of these horses according to their age. Finally, a northern Marinera dance performance will take place, where visitors can take photographs. After the visit, departure transfer.

TRUJILLO AND CHICLAYO: MILLENIAL LAND

DAY 1 | ARRIVAL IN TRUJILLO - HUACA LUNA & MUSEUM

Reception at the Bus Station or Airport. Accommodation at hotels. Free morning.

At the scheduled time, we will pick you up from your accommodation in private transportation and head about 9 kilometers south of Trujillo, where most of the businesses in Trujillo are located. We will cross the Moche River bridge, the main tributary of this city, and after a certain distance, we will take a left turn to enter the Moche countryside, a picturesque place where most of the restaurants and rural bars in the city are situated. The climate is quite pleasant, with fertile agriculture where crops such as corn, artichokes, onions, and others are grown, highlighting a typical fruit of our region called Pacae or Guaba. Our first stop will be at the exterior of the Huaca del Sol; access is currently restricted, but it is possible to observe it from the outside. It is known that this construction was part of the administrative area of the Moche urban zone. Our next stop will be at the Las Huacas de Moche Site Museum, inaugurated on June 24, 2010, where pieces found throughout the archaeological area and surroundings are displayed. It features thematic rooms where various manifestations of Moche Culture are exhibited. The Moche Culture developed between 100 and 700 AD. Continuing with our tour, we will visit the archaeological part of the Huaca de La Luna, where we will explore its various areas, highlighting the polychrome murals in high relief, a fine artistic expression of their worldview, with the figure of AI APAEC, a Moche deity also known as the "killer god" or "decapitator." His figure was represented in all Moche iconography. This culture lacked writing, but its greatest legacy was its pottery, with fine works in clay, highlighting the famous huaco portraits, faithful replicas of typical Moche features, as well as paintings that represent rituals of human sacrifice, races, the use of hallucinogens, and sexual activities. Their daily life and important activities were captured through iconography on pottery. After the visit, we will return to your accommodation.

DAY 2 | TRANSFER TO TRUJILLO - EL BRUJO COMPLEX IN ROUTE + CAO MUSEUM - CHICLAYO

At the scheduled time, we will pick you up from your accommodation to head about 60 kilometers northeast of Trujillo. We will travel for approximately 1 hour along the Pan-American North Highway, where the landscape is arid at first, but over time becomes fertile, thanks to the Chavimochic irrigation project, named after the valleys of Chao, Virú, Moche, and Chicama. This project aims to harness rainwater by creating reservoirs and using it for agriculture, which has turned this area into a producer of sugarcane since the Republican era. After some distance, we will reach Chocope, where we will take a left turn to reach the peaceful town of Magdalena de Cao, a place known for its artisans and producers of the famous Niña del Año. Passing this town, we will arrive at the El Brujo Archaeological Complex, open to the public since 2006, where we will visit the Cao Museum, inaugurated in 2009. It is a modern building that displays objects found in this area. The museum has thematic rooms with videos explaining the activities carried out by the Moche people. At the end of the tour, we will visit the room where the Lady of Cao is displayed, a high-ranking figure in Moche culture who died young due to a postpartum complication. We will then visit the archaeological site that remains standing thanks to conservation efforts. Once the visit is complete, we will return along the same route we took from Chocope and continue our journey for approximately 2 and a half hours along the Pan-American North Highway, passing through the sugarcane fields of the Casa Grande and Paiján sugar empire. After some distance, we will enter the Paiján desert, where dunes are formed. We will pass through San Pedro de Lloc, the "city of God." In this area, we will take the turnoff to the city of Cajamarca, where the road borders the Gallito Ciego reservoir. We will pass through the areas of Guadalupe and Chepén in the valley, known for the cultivation of rice, which is widely used in our cuisine. We will pass the Pacanguilla toll, which marks the boundary between the La Libertad region and where we enter the Lambayeque region, passing through the populated areas of Mocupe and Reque, where we will cross the Chancay-Río Reque bridge, welcoming us to the city of Chiclayo.



DAY 3 | FULL DAY "LORD OF SIPÁN"

Complementing the Moche Route, it is time to learn about the Lord of Sipán and the high leaders of the Moche culture.

Huaca Rajada is the site where the Lord of Sipán was found in 1987, which was the richest tomb in Peru.

Lunch in Lambayeque, followed by the much-anticipated visit to the Royal Tombs of Sipán Museum, considered one of the top 10 museums in the world. This museum houses all the jewels (nose rings, ear cuffs, pectorals, necklaces, and bracelets), as well as pottery and the body of the Lord of Sipán and his ancestors.

To complete the experience, we will finish with a visit to the Bruning Museum to gain insight into the evolution of cultures in Lambayeque.

DAY 4 | DEPARTURE FROM CHICLAYO

At the scheduled time, we will pick you up from your accommodation and transfer you to the Chiclayo bus station or airport.



It is undoubtedly the most modern and impressive museum in Peru, housing the complete collection of archaeological treasures from the northern coast, including samples from the Vicús culture. The treasure extracted from the Royal Tombs of Sipán is safeguarded in this wonderful museum, making it its main attraction. Finally, we will complete our tour with a visit to the Port of Pimentel, 11 km from Chiclayo. Here, traditional surfing competitions, boarding, beach volleyball, totora reed boats, and cord fishing are practiced.

During our journey, we will pass by beautiful beaches until we reach Caleta de Santa Rosa, known for the use of the Totora reed boats. We will continue the trip to the city of Eten, known as "The third Eucharistic city in the world." We will visit the Port of Eten and then head to the village of Monsefú, famous for its straw and thread weaving. Return to the city of Chiclayo. Transfer to the hotel.

DAY 3 | CHICLAYO - TÚCUME - DEPARTURE

Breakfast at the hotel.

Guided visit to Túcume, also known as the Valley of the Pyramids. In the 200 hectares of the Túcume area, 26 monumental adobe structures in the shape of pyramids were built, serving various functions such as rituals, housing, commercial purposes, and other aspects of city life. Due to their size and the quality of the monuments, the pyramids of Túcume are one of the main monumental centers in the region and in Peru. Return to the hotel.

We will witness their customs, which remain unchanged. You can observe the daily activities of the islanders. There are two options to reach the village: the first is for those who enjoy physical effort; you need to climb 533 steps up the island to reach the entrance arch and then descend to the main square. The second is a gentle slope that leads to the village, which takes about 1 hour to walk.

In the afternoon, return to Puno. Arrival and transfer to the hotel in Puno.
